AUDI STUDENT SCHEDULE

Students attend Sheridan Technical College (STC) on Mondays and Tuesdays from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm while working at their sponsoring Audi dealership part time the rest of the week. Students will work approximately 20 to 30 hours per week at an Audi dealership, under the supervision of a Master Technician, earning \$11.00 per hour totaling approximately \$27,000 during the program.

CERTIFICATION

Audi students will be trained and encouraged to take the ASE Automobile Certification Tests during the normal length of the program and should have at least four (4) ASE certifications upon graduation. Students will also obtain official Audi Factory Training in a variety of areas. This training is recognized by Audi Dealers nationwide.

TYPICAL AUDI GRADUATE EARNING

As technology increases in automobiles, the need for highly skilled factory trained automobile technicians also increases. The average Audi graduate should earn into the \$40,000 range within a couple of years after graduation. Many technicians earn over \$50,000 a year and it is not unusual to earn over \$75,000 a year. - Attend orientation at STC (Main or West campus)
- Complete a basic skills test (Cost \$10 plus a picture ID required)
- Meet with guidance counselor at STC West 754-321-3900
- Meet with Audi Program Coordinator Edgard Solis
- Secure employment with a sponsoring Dealership

- Have a valid driver's license with four (4) or less points in the last three (3) years
- Meet "drug free" workplace requirements
- Complete a background check
