2024-25 TEAS Test



The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) is designed to specifically assess students' preparedness entering the health science fields. This assessment is required for Practical Nursing only. Students must first meet basic skills via the CASAS/TABE or meet exemption/exit criteria before being approved to take the TEAS.

TEAS Testing (Test of Essential Academic Skills)

Test Requirements & Procedures

Who Should Test

Only prospective Practical Nursing students must take and pass the TEAS test prior to admissions. Students must first meet basic skills via the CASAS Goals Reading and Math or meet exemption criteria before taking the TEAS.

Subject/ Length/ Format

The TEAS computer-based test assess students in the areas of Reading, Math, Science, and English/Language Usage. The test is administered in-person at STC's main campus in Hollywood and consists of 170 questions which equate to 209 minutes (about 4 hours). The following outlines the allotted number of questions and time for each subject.

- Reading: 64 minutes to complete 53 questions
- Math: 54 minutes to complete 36 questions
- Science: 63 minutes to complete 53 questions
- English & Language: 28 minutes to complete 28 questions

Registration Procedures/ Cost

Register for the TEAS at the registration after getting approval from the program counselor/advisor. There is a \$75.00 testing fee and a valid picture ID is required. Acceptable forms of payment are cash, Visa or Mastercard. The cardholder must be present in order to process in-person payments. Payment is the first step in the registration process. Once the payment is processed, the registrar will provide you with next steps.

Schedule

Testing is available Tuesdays at 1:00 PM.

Location: Main Campus (Building 12)

*By appointment only. Registration must be completed no later than the Friday before the desired testing date.

Acceptable Identification

A valid (not expired) photo ID is required to register and test. Examples of acceptable identification include: state issued driver's license, state issued identification card, permanent resident card, employment authorization card or passport. Foreign driver's licenses are not permitted.

Test Accommodations

Test accommodations may be available for individuals who self-identify as having a documented disability. Requests for accommodations must be made prior to testing via the Exceptional Education Specialist. Refer to Step 4 (Request Disability Services) of the online admission process for details.

Results

The passing score is 55% total. Your scores will be available to view immediately after testing, however, ATI provides the final score report 24 to 48 hours after testing. Once you have passed the TEAS and completed the entire admissions process, contact the program counselor Victor Calderon at 754.321.5443 for the counselor interview.

Special Considerations

Children, food and drinks are not permitted in the testing room.

Exemption Criteria

You may be exempt from testing if you earned 75% or higher on the HESI. STC does not administer this exam, so an official HESI score report from an approved testing center or institution is required.
