OPEN DOOR GRANT

Grant Overview

The Open Door Scholarship Program 2024-2025, funded by the Florida Department of Education, is designed to support students completing short-term and technical education credentialing courses. The grant covers 100% of the cost of tuition associated with the eligible courses, not otherwise covered by federal/state grants or other third-party payments.

Awarded funds only apply to the term for which the application is submitted. The student is responsible for the cost of subsequent terms. Books/supplies are not covered. Funds are subject to availability and will be awarded once the application is approved and all other aid is applied. Refer to application for more details.

Deadline

Thursday, May 22, 2025 (12:00 PM).

Eligible Programs

Requirements

- 1. Meet eligibility for Florida Residency for Tuition Purposes.
- 2. Enrolled in an eligible Career Technical Education (CTE) program (list on next page).
- 3. Enrolled in a course starting on June 2, 2025 June 6, 2025 only.
- 4. Complete the 2025-26 FAFSA application process (*not required for Child Care Center Operations, Commercial "Class B" Driving, Commercial Vehicle Driving, Phlebotomy*). Open Door Grant funds are applied after federal and state aid, or third-party payments, to cover a maximum award equal to the amount needed to cover 100% of tuition for the term. Books/supplies are not covered. Refer to the next page for a list of eligible programs.

How to Apply

New Student:

- 1. Complete the admissions process and receive an acceptance letter from the program counselor/advisor.
- Meet requirements listed above and submit the Open Door application (page 3) and program acceptance letter to the Office of Student Financial Aid to determine eligibility (Main Campus - Building 11).

Currently Enrolled Student (Previous Applicant):

1. Current students who received the Open Door grant for Winter term do not need to submit an application. The Open Door Grant will be applied to your Focus student portal once you have been reauthorized by the instructor. Once the grant is applied to your tuition there should be a \$0.00 balance. You must select "Complete Payment", to accept the grant and register.

Currently Enrolled (Have not applied for Open Door Grant for 2024-25 school year):

- 1. Currently enrolled students who did not submit an Open Door application for the 2025-26 school year, must first be reauthorized by the program instructor.
- 2. Meet requirements listed above and submit the Open Door application (page 3) to the Office of Student Financial Aid to determine eligibility (Main Campus Building 11).

Returning Inactive Student (Withdrawn student who wishes to re-enroll):

- 1. Contact the program counselor/advisor to discuss steps to re-enroll and obtain the reauthorization form.
- 2. Meet requirements listed above and submit the Open Door application (page 3) and the counselor/advisor generated reauthorization form to the Office of Student Financial Aid to determine eligibility (Main Campus Building 11).

- 1. Applications must be submitted in-person to the Office of Student Financial Aid (Building 11) no later than 12:00 PM on Thursday, May 22, 2025.
- 2. The Open Door Grant applies to eligible CTE programs and is currently being offered for courses starting June 2-6, 2025 only.
- 3. Students who are considered non-Florida residents for tuition purposes do not qualify even if receiving a fee exemption for out-of-state tuition fees.
- 4. Open Door Grant funds are applied after federal and state aid, or third-party payments, to cover a maximum award equal to the amount needed to cover 100% of tuition for the term. Sheridan Technical College is required to reduce or cancel the grant award if the student later becomes eligible for other financial assistance during the 2024-25 school year.
- 5. Funds are subject to availability and priority is given to currently enrolled students.
- 6. Notification of application status will be provided at the time of application submission. If awarded, funds must be used for the Summer term (June 2-6, 2025) only. For current students, funds will be applied to the Focus student portal. New and returning inactive students will receive an award notification letter.
- 7. Awarded funds only apply to the term for which the application is submitted. The student is responsible for the cost of subsequent terms. Books/supplies are not covered.
- 8. Qualified students who have already paid out-of-pocket for the Summer (June 2-6, 2025) term, will be refunded eligible fees.
