#### **Description of Program**

The Child Care Center Operations program is designed to prepare students to earn the Florida Child Care Director's Credential, a requirement mandated by the Florida Legislature for directors of licensed child care facilities. This program is an approved course by the Department of Children and Families (DCF) and is listed on the State of Florida's "Overview of Child Care Management" approved course list. The curriculum focuses on essential aspects of child care center administration, including organizational leadership, personnel policies and procedures, staff recruitment and retention, financial management, and legal responsibilities. Students also explore program development for culturally sensitive and inclusive environments, educational programming, marketing strategies, monitoring practices, observation and assessment techniques, referrals, and collaboration with families and community resources. The role of a child care center director is multifaceted and demands a high level of dedication, knowledge, and expertise in program administration. This program integrates theory with practical application to ensure students are fully prepared to meet the responsibilities of child care leadership.

### Florida Residency for Tuition Purposes

A "Florida resident for tuition purposes" is defined as someone who has, or a dependent person whose parent, legal guardian, or spouse has, established and maintained legal residence in Florida for at least twelve consecutive months prior to the first day of the academic term. Individuals who do not meet this requirement are classified as non-Florida residents and are subject to a higher tuition rate. To be considered for in-state tuition, applicants must complete the *Florida Residency Affidavit for Tuition Purposes* and submit *two supporting documents* that verify Florida residency. For detailed information on acceptable documentation and to access the form, please refer to the admissions process or contact a program counselor or advisor for assistance.

#### **Basic Skills**

Students enrolled in programs of 450 hours or more are required to take and pass a basic skills test in order to receive a Career Technical Education certificate upon program completion. However, students enrolled in

programs that are less than 450 hours or Applied Technology Diploma (ATD) programs are not required to take the basic skills test. Additionally, some students may qualify for exemptions based on specific criteria.
