## COMMERCIAL CLASS "B" DRIVING



#### **Description of Program**

The Commercial "Class B" Driving Program is designed to prepare students for entry-level employment as professional local truck drivers. This program provides comprehensive training in essential skills such as loading and unloading cargo, maneuvering and backing straight trucks, and understanding truck controls and systems. Students also receive instruction in trip planning and proper use of hours-of-service regulations and logbooks. Throughout the program, students will complete 200 miles of driving on both local and highway roads, gaining valuable real-world experience. The curriculum integrates theoretical knowledge with hands-on practice, ensuring students are well-prepared to obtain their Commercial Class "B" Driver License (CDL). CDL testing is included in the program at no additional cost, providing a seamless path from training to certification.

## Florida Residency for Tuition Purposes

A "Florida resident for tuition purposes" is defined as someone who has, or a dependent person whose parent, legal guardian, or spouse has, established and maintained legal residence in Florida for at least twelve consecutive months prior to the first day of the academic term. Individuals who do not meet this requirement are classified as non-Florida residents and are subject to a higher tuition rate. To be considered for in-state tuition, applicants must complete the *Florida Residency Affidavit for Tuition Purposes* and submit *two supporting documents* that verify Florida residency. For detailed information on acceptable documentation and to access the form, please refer to the admissions process or contact a program counselor or advisor for assistance.

## **Basic Skills**

Students enrolled in programs of 450 hours or more are required to take and pass a basic skills test in order to receive a Career Technical Education certificate upon program completion. However, students enrolled in

programs that are less than 450 hours or Applied Technology Diploma (ATD) programs are not required to take the basic skills test. Additionally, some students may qualify for exemptions based on specific criteria.
