Description of Program

The Audi / Corporate Dealer Exclusive Training Program is a two-year training program designed to prepare students for careers as professional automotive technicians. This program is offered in partnership with Audi of America and a network of local dealerships representing a wide range of manufacturers including Honda, Acura, Mazda, Volvo, Volkswagen, Hyundai, KIA, Subaru, BMW, and Mercedes-Benz. Students enrolled in this program will benefit from a combination of classroom instruction and hands-on, paid work experience at a local dealership. Under the quidance of a Master Technician, students will develop advanced automotive service technology and mechanical skills. The program also provides access to OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer) training that is recognized by dealerships across the country, giving students a competitive edge in the job market.

The curriculum is designed to prepare students for the Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) certification exams. Students have the ability to graduate as Master ASE Certified Technicians by completing all eight ASE certifications, demonstrating comprehensive expertise across key automotive service areas. In addition to technical training, students are encouraged to pursue academic advancement by attending one evening class per week at Broward College, working toward an Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree in Automotive Technology. Before being admitted to the program, prospective students must contact the program instructor to receive assistance in securing employment at a participating local dealership. Florida Residency for Tuition Purposes

A "Florida resident for tuition purposes" is defined as someone who has, or a dependent person whose parent, legal guardian, or spouse has, established and maintained legal residence in Florida for at least twelve consecutive months prior to the first day of the academic term. Individuals who do not meet this requirement are classified as non-Florida residents and are subject to a higher tuition rate. To be considered for in-state tuition, applicants must complete the Florida Residency Affidavit for Tuition Purposes and submit two supporting documents that verify Florida residency. For detailed information on acceptable documentation and to access the form, please refer to the admissions process or contact a program counselor or advisor for assistance.

Basic Skills

Students enrolled in programs of 450 hours or more are required to take and pass a basic skills test in order to receive a Career Technical Education certificate upon program completion. However, students enrolled in programs that are less than 450 hours or Applied Technology Diploma (ATD) programs are not required to take the basic skills test. Additionally, some students may qualify for exemptions based on specific criteria. For detailed information
