












#### **Description of Program**

The Mazda Automotive Student Training (MAST) Program is a two-year training program designed to prepare students for careers as professional automotive technicians. This program is offered in partnership with Mazda North American Operations and local Mazda dealerships and combines classroom instruction with paid, hands-on dealership experience under the quidance of Master Technicians. Students gain advanced mechanical skills and in-depth knowledge of Mazda's innovative technologies, including SKYACTIV® engines, i-ACTIVSENSE® safety systems, and the MAZDA CONNECT™ infotainment platform. Mazda-specific OEM training is fully integrated into the curriculum, equipping students with the expertise needed to pursue Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) certifications and careers as Mazda-Certified Technicians. Students have the ability to graduate as Master ASE Certified Technicians by completing all eight ASE certifications. In addition to technical training, students are encouraged to take one evening course per week toward earning an Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree in Automotive Technology.

# Florida Residency for Tuition Purposes

A "Florida resident for tuition purposes" is defined as someone who has, or a dependent person whose parent, legal guardian, or spouse has, established and maintained legal residence in Florida for at least twelve consecutive months prior to the first day of the academic term. Individuals who do not meet this requirement are classified as non-Florida residents and are subject to a higher tuition rate. To be considered for in-state tuition, applicants must complete the *Florida Residency Affidavit for Tuition Purposes* and submit *two supporting documents* that verify Florida residency. For detailed information on acceptable documentation and to access the form, please refer to the admissions process or contact a program counselor or advisor for assistance.

## **Basic Skills**

Students enrolled in programs of 450 hours or more are required to take and pass a basic skills test in order to receive a Career Technical Education certificate upon program completion. However, students enrolled in programs that are less than 450 hours or Applied Technology Diploma (ATD) programs are not required to take the basic skills test. Additionally, some students may qualify for exemptions based on specific criteria.
