### Description of Program

The Nail Specialty Program is designed to provide students with the skills and techniques needed to become licensed Nail Specialists in the state of Florida. Nail technicians, also known as manicurists or pedicurists, offer professional nail care services to clients in a variety of settings. The program covers a wide range of topics including communication, leadership, human relations, and employability skills, as well as safe and efficient work practices. Students will gain a thorough understanding of Florida cosmetology laws and rules, nail care chemistry, bacteriology, anatomy and physiology. The curriculum also focuses on developing the technical skills required to perform manicures, pedicures, nail enhancements, and other services essential to the nail specialty profession. The combination of theory and hands-on practice, prepares students to enter the beauty industry as licensed professionals.

## Florida Residency for Tuition Purposes

A "Florida resident for tuition purposes" is defined as someone who has, or a dependent person whose parent, legal guardian, or spouse has, established and maintained legal residence in Florida for at least twelve consecutive months prior to the first day of the academic term. Individuals who do not meet this requirement are classified as non-Florida residents and are subject to a higher tuition rate. To be considered for in-state tuition, applicants must complete the Florida Residency Affidavit for Tuition Purposes and submit two supporting documents that verify Florida residency. For detailed information on acceptable documentation and to access the form, please refer to the admissions process or contact a program counselor or advisor for assistance.

## Basic Skills

Students enrolled in programs of 450 hours or more are required to take and pass a basic skills test in order to receive a Career Technical Education certificate upon program completion. However, students enrolled in programs that are less than 450 hours are not required to take the basic skills test. Additionally, some students may qualify for exemptions based on specific criteria.
